Dakota Creek

3258 Haynie Rd., Custer

Is an 18-hole public regulation course located 20 minutes north of Bellingham. It has some of the best views in the county. They tout good prices, a well maintained course and low-key atmosphere.

Homestead Golf Resort

Is an 18-hole very flat course with lots of water and sand. The 18th hole features the only par 5 to an island green in the Pacific Northwest. Also, has an 18-hole, par 71 championship putting course (\$5).

Is an 18-hole very tight and densely treed municipal golf course with a hilly back nine. Recognized as one of the finest municipal golf courses in the Pacific Northwest. This course is carved out of a second growth forest.

Is an 18-hole course with water and sand throughout. While golfing, enjoy spectacular views of Mt. Baker. Water is on eight of the 18 holes.

Is a 9-hole course with large greens and boasts great drainage for year-round golfing. It challenges all levels of play.

Is an extremely scenic 18-hole golf course with two very different nines ~ the front nine is flat and runs along Lake Whatcom and the back nine is hilly and heavily treed. Water hazards are on 14 of the 18 holes.
